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
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

Victor Frankenstein, the infamous scientist of legend, has died and left his estate to his grandson, Frederick, an eminent Dean of Anatomy at a world-renowned School of Medicine. Frederick wants nothing to do with the family's notorious legacy, but to settle his inheritance, travels to his grandfather's castle in Transylvania, where he meets Igor, the grandson of Victor's loyal henchman, Inga, the beautiful lab assistant, and Frau Blücher, the mysterious housekeeper.

Before long, Frederick is sucked into his grandfather's experiments and succeeds in creating human life. But the Monster has, accidentally, been given the wrong brain, and escapes, seemingly set to terrorise everyone like the monsters before him. Will Frederick repeat the mistakes of his grandfather? Or will he succeed and turn his Monster into a dapper, intelligent man about town?

The stage show is based on the Oscar-nominated 1974 smash hit movie of the same name which starred and was co-written by the late Gene Wilder. The musical follows the plot of the film, which itself is a parody of the Hollywood horror films of the 1930s. The book of the musical was written by Mel Brooks and Thomas Meehan, who had previously collaborated on the musical adaptation of *The Producers*.

Young Frankenstein originally opened on stage in New York in November 2007. Following a pre-West End try out at the Theatre Royal Newcastle, a revised version of the Broadway show, with new dialogue and songs, arrived at the Garrick Theatre in London's West End in September 2017 to rave reviews, playing there for over a year. The show was released to amateur companies in 2021. The UK version of the show made its debut in the US last month.



John Hebden Director

John first performed with Green Room in the mid 1990's. The company, after one show, took the wise decision to 'get him off stage' and into a more responsible directing role. Some ten years ago he got the opportunity to direct Mel Brooks' *The Producers* and he is delighted to have been able to work on Mel's second musical offering *Young Frankenstein*. As always it has been so good to work with Michelle, Simon and John and with Alastair completing the creative team.



John Isaac Assistant Director

One of John's most-treasured memories with Green Room is the time spent playing Leo Bloom in Mel Brooks' other madcap musical, *The Producers* in 2011. The NODA review said his performance was reminiscent of "a young John Hebden" - the highest accolade! He is now extremely grateful to be under John Hebden's tutelage again, but this time as part of the Creative Team. John retired from performing in 2021 having played his dream role, Henry Higgins, in ELODS' production of *My Fair Lady*.
